BLEND: 100% Chardonnay

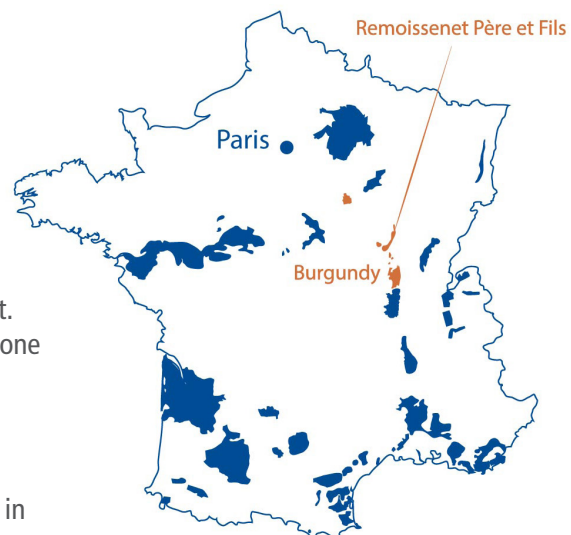
VINEYARDS: Selected (purchased) fruit from the 'Macherelles' vineyard, located on the Puligny side of the village, closer to grand cru Montrachet. The plot has iron-rich soils, with the "mother rock" of Burgundian limestone not far from the surface.

AGE OF VINES: 20-40 years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Pressed full cluster then fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled, stainless steel tanks. Aged in French oak barrels (25-40% new).

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of white flowers, lime zest and crushed stones. Fresh, silky yet concentrated; flavors of crisp pear, warm lemon, sea salt. Structured and long.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Grilled chicken; soft-rind French cheeses; sushi



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
