Domaine Arlaud is a reference point for natural Burgundy wines. Preserving the health and character of their vineyards is of utmost importance to this generations-deep biodynamic winemaking clan. For more than 20 years we've partnered with this family from Morey-Saint-Denis, witnessing each vintage the ever-greater clarity of expression they have been able to achieve in each of their harmonious Burgundy wines. Today the Arlauds stand side-by-side with Burgundy's most respected names. As of the 2014 vintage, the estate will hold both organic and biodynamic certification, the very first to do so in Morey-Saint-Denis.

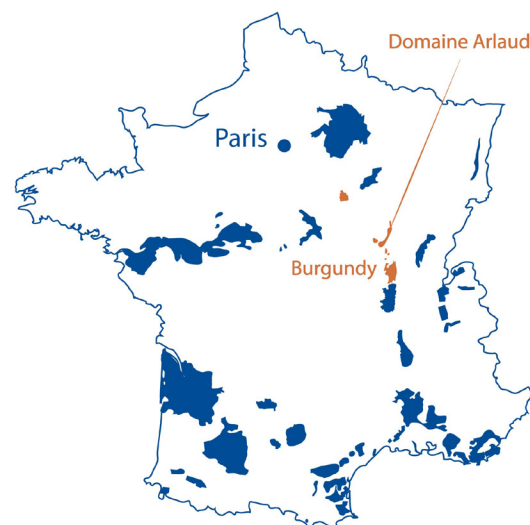
VINEYARDS: 'Roncevie' is surrounded by villages-level vines of Gevrey-Chambertin, and shares essentially identical exposition and soils. The estate founder, Joseph Arlaud (winemaker Cyprien Arlaud's grandfather), planted Pinot Noir vines here in 1964 and 1965. The 12-acre plot was at the time rated Gevrey villages; it was reclassified as Bourgogne Rouge a year later.

AGE OF VINES: 50+ years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Fermented on indigenous yeasts in cement tanks; aged in older French oak barrels. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of blueberries, raspberries and irises. Medium-bodied and juicy, with a hint of baking spices on the finish.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Autumn flavors, such as pork roast with chestnuts, wild mushrooms



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
