



TERRES SECRÈTES

Mâcon-Verzé 'Croix Jarrier'

Terres Secrètes is one of France's more celebrated cooperative wineries, founded in the 1950s and supported by dozens of talented growers in the greater Mâconnais. We first came across this exceptional group when sampling a bottle of Crémant de Bourgogne that we could have sworn was a fine Blanc de Noirs from the Montagne de Reims—the quality coming from this Prissé-based winery is exceptional, in both sparkling and still wines. Sourcing older-vine fruit from the Mâconnais' top terroirs, including Vergisson, Saint-Véran and Viré-Clessé, Terres Secrètes selections are indeed southern Burgundy's best-kept secret.

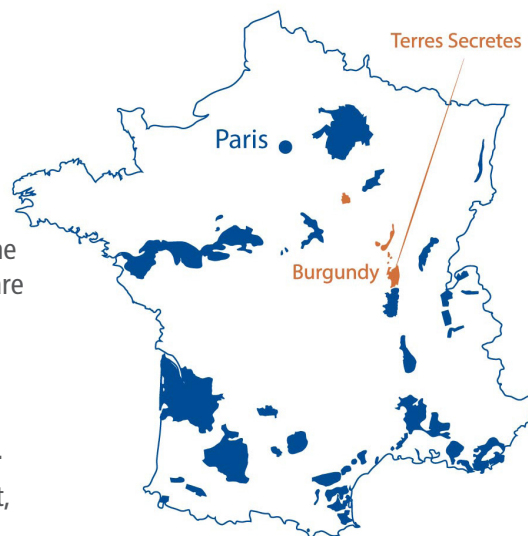
VINEYARDS: Sourced from the single vineyard 'Croix Jarrier,' located in the village of Verzé on a slope, at 870 feet in altitude and facing west. Soils are chalky, with white limestone.

AGE OF VINES: 20 to 40 years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled, stainless steel tanks. Aged in tank for 12 months.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of crushed chalk and smoke, white fruit, wildflowers. Light bodied, with flavors of pear and apple, with a savory finish

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: As an aperitif; seafood such as scallops; white meats



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
