Friuli Pinot Bianco

To the northeast, the towering Alps; to the south, the placid Adriatic Sea. The Maccan family couldn't have found a more charmed spot to cultivate Friuli's native grapes. Here along the banks of the Livenza river in the foothills of the Alps, the classic stones of Grave mix with limestone, giving a Burgundian finesse to Friulano and Refosco. With some 37 acres planted to Friuli's native grapes, the Maccan family harvests their bounty by hand and crafts character-rich, single-varietal wines that effortlessly reflect the breathtaking beauty of this mountain refuge.

VINEYARDS: Estate vineyards are planted on clay- and limestone-rich soils, unique to the region, with topsoils of gravel, the classic terroir of Grave.

AGE OF VINES: 30 years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Pressed, then fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled, stainless steel tanks. Aged on fine lees in tank.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of white peaches, pineapple, warm spices. Medium-bodied and plush, with good acidic balance.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Grilled fish or shellfish; pork terrine or pâté; chicken with herbs



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
