Gevrey-Chambertin 'Jeunes Rois' 2015

With his impressive selection of premier cru and grand cru terroirs, Frédéric Magnien offers the most complete experience for those passionate about Burgundy wines. Frédéric is a fifth-generation winemaker from Morey-Saint-Denis; Burgundy is the family's lifeblood. Learning the craft first from his father Michel Magnien (of Domaine Michel Magnien), Frédéric traveled abroad to hone his talents before returning home and starting his own négociant house. As a négociant, Frédéric differentiates himself in that he works closely with his partner growers through every step of the growing year, selecting only older-vine parcels that are cared for to his exacting standards.

VINEYARDS: The 'Jeunes Rois' vineyard, facing east, is located in Brochon, at the border of Gevrey-Chambertin. Soils are stony and poor; the vineyard is surrounded by a stone wall which traps heat, helping grapes to ripen.

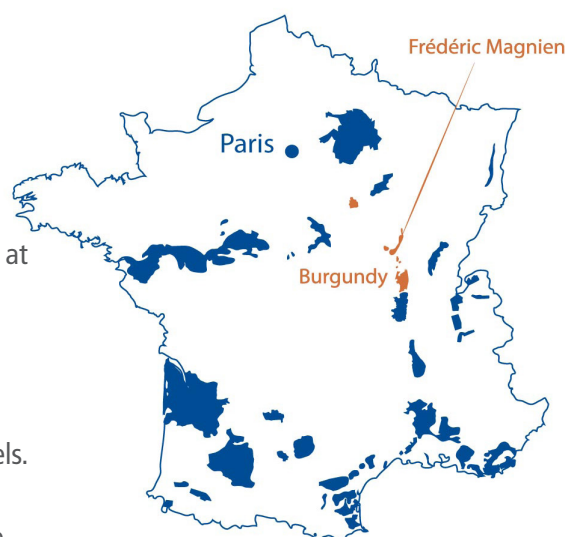
AGE OF VINES: 60+ years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled, stainless steel tank. Aged in older French oak barrels. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of red cherries, pomegranate jam, white peaches. Savory and plush; juicy black cherry and blackberry flavors.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Grilled steak with pepper; roasted autumn vegetables.

NOTES: 'Jeunes Rois' in French means "young kings."



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
