Coteaux Bourguignons 'Les Grandes Gouttes' Pinot Noir

Winemaker Vincent Boyer of Domaine Boyer-Martenot has teamed up with his childhood friend Emmanuel Lucas De Bar, who owns vineyards in the Hérault valley in France's Languedoc, to form a winemaking partnership across appellations. Organically raised and crafted with the same care as Vincent's peerless Meursault wines, these new, very limited-quantity wines combine the pleasure of the sunny south with serious Burgundian quality—and represent excellent value, too.

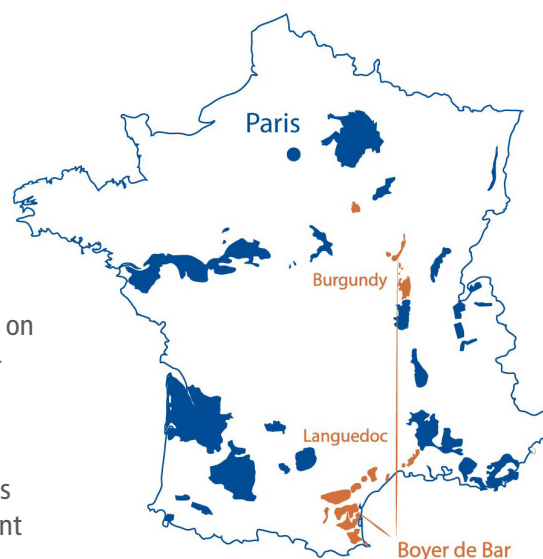
VINEYARDS: 'Les Grands Gouttes' is a south/southeast-facing vineyard on the plains south of the village of Meursault, on the border with Puligny-Montrachet. Soils are deep and rich, a mix of loam and limestone.

AGE OF VINES: 10 years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Destemmed; fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled tanks. Aged in a combination of cement egg and tank for 20 months. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of red cherry, wild strawberry, crushed stones, light peppery spice. Fresh and juicy, great balance, silky

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: As an aperitif with charcuterie; roasted chicken and herbs; pork terrine



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
