Run by the same family since 1961, the Paesani distillery is perched on a hillside in the hamlet of Collevecchio, with the highest peak in the Apennine Mountains, the Gran Sasso d'Italia, as its backdrop and namesake. Antonio Paesani and his son Mirco painstakingly craft by hand their award-winning lineup of amari and other liqueurs in this mountainous setting in Italy's heartland of Abruzzo. The Amaro Gran Sasso, a balanced infusion of more than 20 botanicals, is the Paesani flagship; yet there is so much to discover here, including a delicately bitter Genziana and a decadent, viscous Liquirizia.
