

DOMAINE ARNAUD BAILLOT

Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru

Arnaud Baillot wasn't born into a winemaking family, as is the case with so many generations-deep Burgundy domaines. He is a winemaker by choice, bringing a new energy and passion to this tradition-steeped region. Originally from Auxerre, Arnaud and his wife Laure (the granddaughter of the founders of Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat) started their adventure as small-batch negociants. Knowing that the character-driven wines they wanted to craft would only be possible when they farmed the land themselves, this focused pair put every penny they had into finding parcels they could own and tend organically. Today the estate is 25 acres of prime land mostly in the Côte de Beaune; their wines are precise, aromatic expressions of Burgundian Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

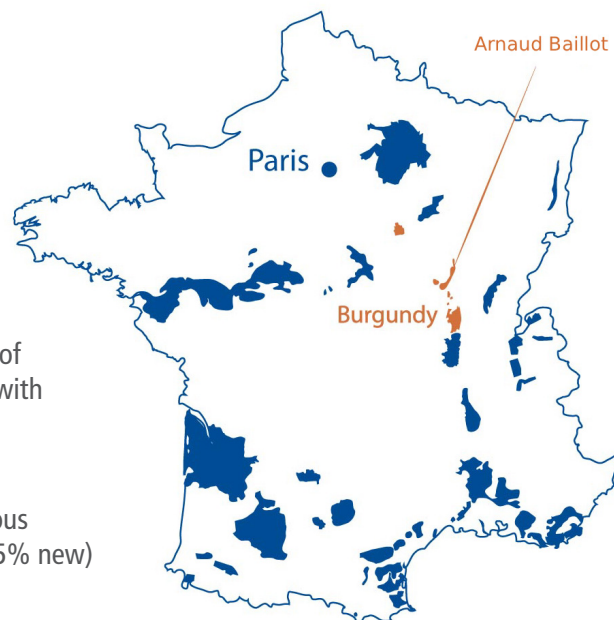
VINEYARDS: Estate vines are found on the Puligny-Montrachet side of Bâtard. Soils, similar to Le Montrachet, combine marl-rich limestone with heavier, more clay-rich topsoils.

AGE OF VINES: 45 years, on average

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Pressed and fermented on indigenous yeasts in French oak barrels with no added sulfites. Aged in barrel (15% new) for 12 months. Unfiltered.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of sautéed lemon and lemon blossom, stony notes, creamy butter. Full-bodied, suave and endlessly silky

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Lobster with drawn butter; shrimp etouffee; roasted chicken with herbs



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
