



DOMAINE ARNAUD BAILLOT

Bourgogne Blanc Côte d'Or

Arnaud Baillot wasn't born into a winemaking family, as is the case with so many generations-deep Burgundy domaines. He is a winemaker by choice, bringing a new energy and passion to this tradition-steeped region. Originally from Auxerre, Arnaud and his wife Laure (the granddaughter of the founders of Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat) started their adventure as small-batch negociants. Knowing that the character-driven wines they wanted to craft would only be possible when they farmed the land themselves, this focused pair put every penny they had into finding parcels they could own and tend organically. Today the estate is 25 acres of prime land mostly in the Côte de Beaune; their wines are precise, aromatic expressions of Burgundian Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Pressed and fermented on indigenous yeasts in older French oak barrels. Aged in barrel (10% new) for 12 months. Unfiltered.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of white flowers, blanched almonds, light honey, ripe white fruit. Medium-bodied, fresh and round, with white fruit and citrus and a lightly savory finish

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: As an aperitif; with river fish; fresh French cheese



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
